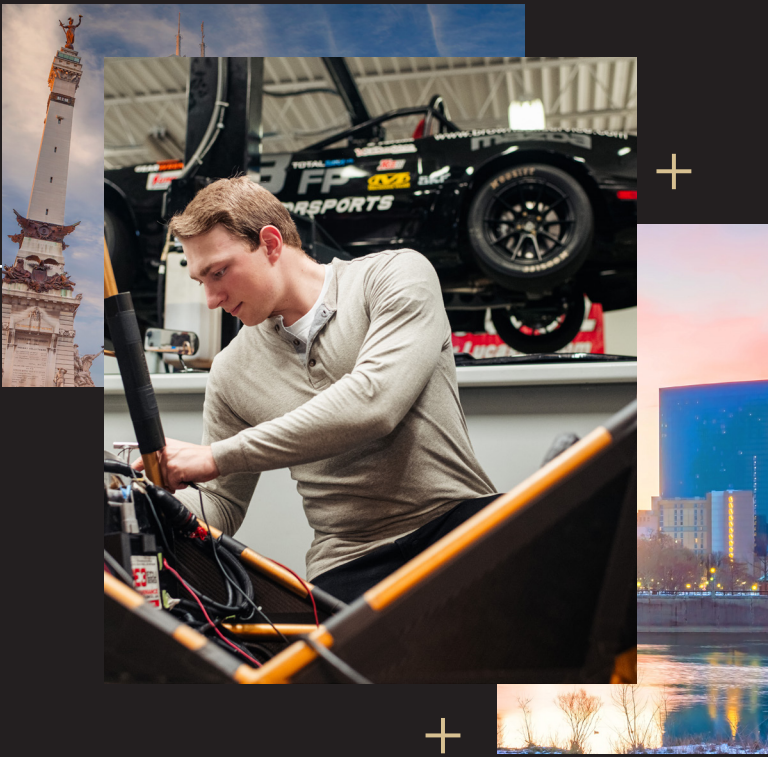

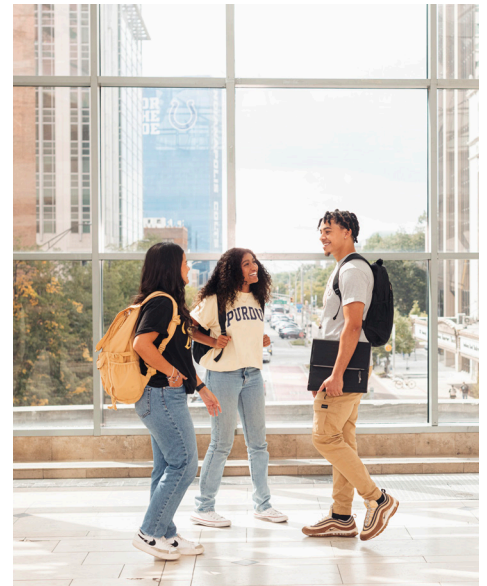

APPLICATION AND HOUSING DETAILS

- **Application Process:** Apply by November 1, 2024 to be considered Early Action and eligible for Merit Scholarships. Admissions standards are the same, and students can participate in activities at both campuses.
- **Curriculum and Major:** Students are directly admitted to their major and follow a core first-year curriculum similar to West Lafayette's First-Year Engineering Program.
